

KA220-VET Cooperation partnerships in vocational education and training Project No: 2021-1-TR01-KA220-VET-000032970

Dear Reader,

As you will remember, "Clinical Key for Electrical Stimulation in Physiotherapy and Rehabilitation (CK4Stim)" is a KA220-VET - Cooperation partnerships in vocational education and training project supported by the Turkish National Agency. The project is based on an electrical stimulation approach and will be conducted over 30 months in partnership with six institutions from Türkiye and EU. Başkent University (BU - Türkiye), University of Craiova (UCV - Romania), Hatay Mustafa Kemal University (HMKU - Türkiye), Süleyman Demirel University (SDU - Türkiye), Šiauliai State University of Applied Sciences (ŠVK - Lithuania), and Mehmet Akif Ersoy University (MAKU) are the partners of the project that is being coordinated by Pamukkale University (PAU - Türkiye).

The 6th Transnational Meeting of CK4Stim was held on 15-16 July 2024 at Burdur Mehmet Akif Ersoy University in Burdur, Türkiye. All partners attended the meeting face to face. The purpose of the 6th meeting was to review quality plans, multiplier events, articles and website. Also, project final report was discussed.

Among those who attended; valuable representatives such as Nilüfer ÇETİŞLİ-KORKMAZ and Fatih CETİŞLİ from Pamukkale University, Eva ILIE, Oana Bianca BUDEANCA BABOLEA and Denisa PIELE from University of Craiova, Zeliha Özlem YÜRÜK from Başkent University, Yasemin KARAASLAN from Hatay Mustafa Kemal University, Mehmet DURAY from Süleyman Demirel University, Dovydas GEDRIMAS from Šiauliai State University of Applied Sciences, and Betül SÖYLEMEZ from Burdur Mehmet Akif Ersoy University were present. It was noted that Nilüfer ÇETİŞLİ-KORKMAZ represented the Turkish Physiotherapy Association, Eva ILIE represented the Order of Physiotherapists in Romania, and Dovydas GEDRIMAS represented the Lithuanian Physiotherapy Association.

The 6th Transnational Meeting of CK4Stim began with welcome coffee held in the Burdur Mehmet Akif Ersoy University, Burdur Vocational School and Health Services' meeting hall. The event began with the opening speeches made by MSc. Betül SÖYLEMEZ and Prof. Nilüfer ÇETİŞLİ-KORKMAZ. After a short opening, all partners started to study on quality plans, multiplier event activities and articles. As you know, at the 5th Transnational Meeting of

CK4Stim, quality plans and dissemination activities were presented and discussed. In 6th Transnational Meeting firstly, Nilüfer ÇETİŞLİ-KORKMAZ provided information about quality plans. Asked partners to document each needed material for quality report. After that, all partners presented their dissemination activities and multiplier events. Partners provided information about the activities which were done, the location, the number of participants and the content of the activities. The project website was reviewed, and general suggestions were discussed. All partners presented the financial issues and short reports on project expenditures. While all partners showed a high level of sensitivity to the financial resources used in the project, Prof. Fatih ÇETİŞLİ, who meticulously maintains the financial reports, presented a detailed and comprehensive summary of the financial report of the project for all partners separately. At the end of the meeting, Prof. Nilüfer ÇETİŞLİ-KORKMAZ distributed the English and Turkish guidebooks printed within the scope of the project to the partners. Prof. ÇETİŞLİ-KORKMAZ also gifted all participants a special plate made with Turkish tile art, the project logos and the inscription "Pamukkale University", as a closing gift.

After the meeting, a tour of "Burdur Cumhuriyet Meydanı" and "Gazi Mustafa Kemal Atatürk Caddesi" was held.
